

# ADRC SERVICES AT A GLANCE

## **DETOXIFICATION CENTER**

Hours of Operation: 24 hours, 7 days a week

This 35-bed facility is the largest freestanding program of its kind in the state. This center offers medically monitored in-patient treatment to clients who are experiencing withdrawal from alcohol and other drugs. Admissions are accepted 24 hours per day. Registered Nurses, Physicians, Counselors and Detox Technicians work together to provide a safe and caring environment.

## **INTENSIVE/INTERMEDIATE RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM**

This 38-bed facility offers intensive (30 days) and intermediate (90 days) programs for adult substance abusers. Our multi-cultural staff conducts individual, group, and family counseling. In addition, there are gender-specific and Spanish language programmings. Medical and psychiatric services are also available as needed.

## **COVENTRY HOUSE**

This 10-bed halfway house for substance-abusing pregnant and post-partum women allows mothers to bring up to two existing children into the treatment facility to avoid disruption of the family unit. Empowerment, self-esteem, abstinence and independence are addressed.

## **CLAYTON HOUSE**

This 15-bed co-ed halfway house provides a structured living environment for clients who need a bridge prior to independent living. The program requires residents to become employed as an integral part of the therapeutic process. Weekly individual and group counseling is provided as well as exposure to self-help groups.

## **INFECTIOUS DISEASE SERVICES**

This program provides ADRC clients with HIV education, risk-reduction assessment, counseling, and HIV testing. Eligible clients may receive referrals to community providers, including HIV case management and Ryan White services.

This 15-bed, long-term transitional housing program for chronic substance-abusing homeless males is a highly successful client-driven model of self-government offering stability and access to existing community services.

This 30-bed program provides a safe, sober living environment for males and females, age 18 or older residing in Region IV, who are receiving S.A.G.A./ G.A. medical (or pending eligibility) or other qualifying benefits, and have substance abuse and/or co-occurring psychiatric disorders awaiting transition to the next level of care.

## **SENIOR OUTREACH PROGRAMS & SERVICES**

Identifies and offers assistance to the increasing numbers of substance abusers age 55 and older in the North Central Region. Specialized treatment is provided to men and women age 60 and above in the Detoxification Center and Alternate Living Center.

ADRC's ROES is an employment support program funded by the CT Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS). Begun in May, 2008, it provides employment assessment and support services to eligible individuals participating in addiction treatment and recovery support services in North Central and Eastern Connecticut.
